B) SCHOLARLY & PROFESSIONAL CONTRIBUTIONS

Brief Overview. My research is focused on motivation for change in psychotherapy and includes three major interrelated contributions: (1) adapting motivational interviewing for anxiety disorders and conducting clinical trials to evaluate this new treatment (2) development and evaluation of a process coding system for measuring and quantifying in-session resistance and (3) the adaptation of a measure of in-session motivational language to the context of CBT for anxiety. In addition to this main body of work, I have also been involved in studies on individual differences in client expectations and help-seeking for mental health treatment among young adults. I have received funding from CIHR (including an operating grant, a new investigator award, and a team grant), NIMH, OMHF, and various local and institutional grants.
